**A Note about Manipur**

Manipur is a tiny, picturesque state in the North East of India; comprising of 10% plain area and 90% hilly terrain. Besides the Meiteis who mostly populate the Imphal Valley, the state is inhabited by 33-odd hill tribes & ethnic groups. Though the majority of the population profess Hinduism, all major religious groups co-exist including Christianity, Islam and Buddhism.

Manipuri is the major language spoken, but many other languages and dialects belonging to Tibeto-Burman family are represented.

During the World War II, the Indian National Army (INA) led by Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose first hoisted the tricolour at Moirang in Manipur. There is an INA war memorial in Moirang, near Loktak Lake, the largest freshwater lake in Eastern India.

Many Japanese soldiers lost their lives in Manipur sector during the second World War; a memorial stand today at Maibam Lotpa Ching, 30 km from Imphal paying tribute to the precious lives of the Japanese soldiers who sacrificed their lives in Manipur; this memorial is regularly frequented by Japanese tourists, officials, and visitors.

**A Note about Manipur University**

Manipur University was established on June 5, 1980 under the Manipur University Act, 1980 (Manipur Act 8 of 1980), as a teaching cum-affiliating university at Imphal with territorial jurisdiction over the whole of the

state of Manipur and it was converted into a central university w.e.f. 13/10/2005.

Located at Canchipur, Imphal, the capital city of Manipur. The university campus is spread over an area of 287 acres in the historic Canchipur, which is the site of the old palace of Manipur.

“The Langthabal Konung” (Palace), was established by Maharaja Gambhir Singh in 1827 A.D. just after the liberation of Manipur from Burmese occupation.

**How to reach Manipur University**

Manipur is well connected with major cities of India by major means of transport. There is daily flight to Imphal from Delhi/Kolkata/Guwahati. The nearest rail station to Imphal is Dimapur. There is also overnight bus service to Imphal from Guwahati/Dimapur.
